Dutchtown Road over Susquehanna River Truss Bridge Rehabilitation and New Bridge Construction

Delta Engineers is excited to announce that we are currently working on the Dutchtown Road over Susquehanna River Truss Bridge Rehabilitation and New Bridge Construction.

This project involves the replacement of an historic truss bridge with an adjacent 2-span bridge crossing the Susquehanna River, including the reconstruction and relocation of 800' of approach roadway. The existing truss bridge is being rehabilitated to serve as a pedestrian structure. A fishing access point and pedestrian trail are also being incorporated. This project included extensive coordination with SHPO, NYSDEC, and the US Army Corps. A threatened and endangered species study was required along the Susquehanna River.

Traffic is being maintained on the existing truss bridge while the new bridge is constructed. Traffic will be switched onto the new bridge following its completion, allowing for the rehabilitation of the existing truss bridge. Services included: preliminary and final bridge and highway design, environmental analyses, river hydraulic study, and construction inspection. This is a locally managed federally funded "pass-thru" project which mandates adherence to NYSDOT design procedures and criteria.
